II. Consent Agenda – Draft Minutes of 03/11/14

The minutes of the March 11, 2014 meeting were approved as drafted.

III. Reports

EDC – Members reviewed the Boston ULI TAP presentation.

CPC – Committee presented recommendations to the Finance Committee; all projects were recommended.

Kelley's Corner Steering Committee - The Cecil Group presented big picture ideas and an outline of project.

IV. Scenic Road Public Hearing - Public Shade Tree Removal on Taylor Road
Joint hearing with Tree Warden

Dean Charter, Town of Acton Tree Warden, proposed the removal of two public shade trees located near 87 Taylor Road. The trees proposed for removal are a 33" DBH Oak and 27" DBH Oak. Mr. Charter stated the trees are a hazard due to their close proximity to the roadway and noted Police Chief Widmayer, Officer Stackhouse and Fire Chief Futterer submitted statements with the same concern. One tree has several marks from cars.

Mr. Hendrie of 89 Taylor Road spoke against removing the two trees. He stated that the trees provide many benefits; aesthetics, habitat, shade and water control. Mr. Hendrie submitted his comments to the Board for the record.

Ray Yacouby moved to recommend the removal of the subject trees. The motion was seconded by Roland Bourdon and was carried unanimously.

Continued Public Hearing – 5 Craig Road SBA Towers/AT&T Cell Tower Application
